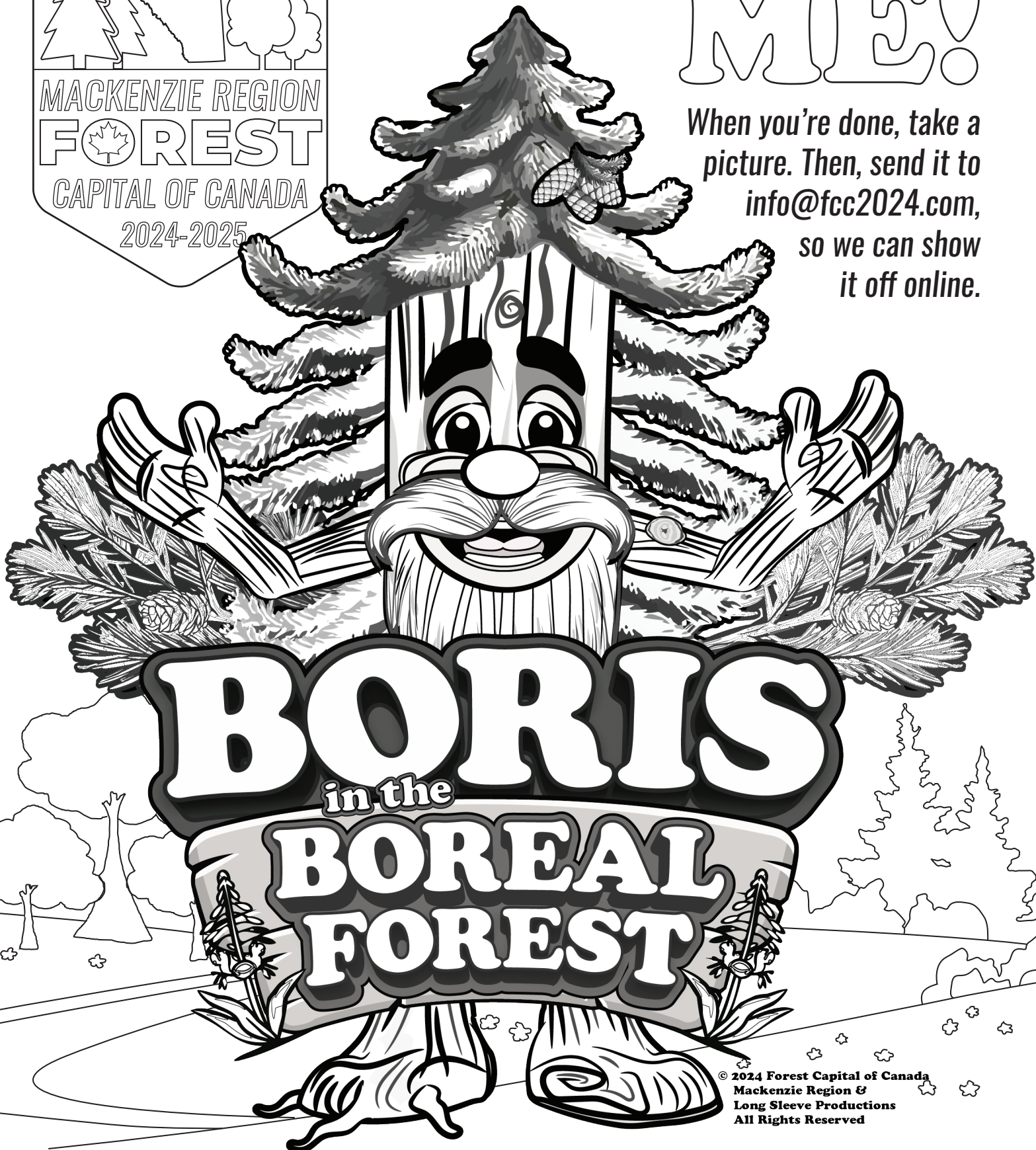
4. **Draw** each part of the plant life cycle before and after a wildfire (*a seed, a sprout, a tree, burnt tree, a seed again*).
